PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES AND BASIC DUTIES

1. Interview potential borrowers to consider loan requests and discuss DBAS MAOTA Affordable Loan Project (MALP), alternatives, credit criteria, and so forth.
 2. Review loan applications using the “4 Cs of Credit” and complete appropriate loan underwriting worksheets for each loan application.
 3. Make recommendations for approval or decline of loan applications based on loan underwriting procedures.
 4. Promote the DBAS MALP through community workshops.
 5. Monitor application in-take and provide loan servicing customer service.
 6. Notify customers about the status of their applications.
 7. Prepare loan files according to relevant file maps for submission to the Compliance Officer for review.
 8. Prepare and execute loan closing documents.
 9. Establish a business relationship with the building material vendors to ensure building materials are available and delivered to construction site(s).
 10. Prepare check requests of approved invoices for Finance to issue checks from GMS.
 11. Monitor disbursement of loan proceeds.
 12. Prepare and issue performance reports for DBAS MALP.
 13. Perform any duties as assigned by Loan Manager or President.
